These questions are being asked by every service provided by the NHS. For example: GPs, Hospitals and Community Services



Answering these questions will help us to know:

- If we are doing a good job, or
- If things could be done better



You can tell us if you think the care you had was good enough for your friends and family.

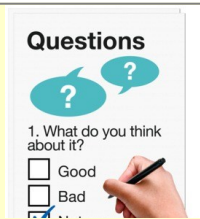


You can answer the question:
